### **Cost (per membership)**

£2 per week enters into 3 weekly draws:

The Must Win Monday (MWM), drawn every Monday

\*\*\*New, The Midweek Money Can't Buy, drawn 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> Wednesday in month\*\*\*

The Abbey Accumulator (AA), drawn every Friday

### **Prizes (as at 18/10/2022)**

Currently 2x £100 per week MWM

Currently 355 members, representing a 1 in 177.5 chance to win the MWM

2 Midweek Must Win prizes each month, a signed shirt & hospitality for 2

The AA increases £50 per week until won, with the winners pot currently sitting at £4,250

Payments are split 50/50 between prize and distribution funds, minus minimal costs

### **Christmas 2022**

Christmas is a coming and the Abbey Accumulator jackpot prize is getting fat! Should the Abbey Accumulator **NOT** be won before Friday 16th December, the prize will be drawn as a Must Win on Friday 23rd December

One CUFC Lottery member would win the jackpot on 23rd December, making it a Christmas to remember

Until then, the jackpot will continue to grow by £50 each week, if there's no winner, so the jackpot could reach £4,750 by 23rd December!

Future jackpot prizes will then be capped at £2,500 and drawn as a Must Win prize.

These changes will ensure a jackpot winner will be found at least once a year
